### *Young Endeavour Tall Ship*

Encourage 16 - 23 year olds to apply for a 11 day voyage on the Young Endeavour tall ship.

*Our ballot is open until 1 April 2007.*

Not for profits and Community organisations can also sponsor a young person to sail and can bypass the ballot selection process. This is an opportunity to offer training in team work, leadership and communication in a unique environment.

#### **Youth crew wanted for tall ship *Young Endeavour***

Young Australians aged 16 - 23 can now apply to sail the tall ship *Young Endeavour* for a youth training program in 2007. Voyages are for 11-days with departures from Townsville, Cairns, Airlie Beach, Bundaberg, Brisbane, Southport, Newcastle, Hobart, Devonport, Adelaide, Port Lincoln and Sydney, available from June – October 2007. Participants do not require any sailing experience.

Over the course of a voyage, 24 youth crew learn from a professional Royal Australian Navy crew all aspects of sailing a 44-metre, square-rigged tall ship on the open sea including climbing the 30m mast, setting sails, navigating, keeping watch and taking the helm.

A voyage on the *Young Endeavour* develops skills in teamwork, communication, leadership and motivation while getting the opportunity to explore wilderness regions and remote coastlines.

Applicants need to be Australian citizens or permanent residents, aged 16 - 23 on the day of departure of the voyage, able to swim 50 metres and be in good health. Youth Crew members are selected via a ballot.

11 day voyages cost \$1,495 with financial assistance available to low-income applicants – conditions apply. Travel assistance is available to residents of WA and NT.

## THE ROVER CREW AND YOUR GROUP

The Rover Crew is the fifth section of the Group and should in turn work towards the fulfilment of its Group's objectives. The Crew needs to recognise that the Group Leader is the head of the Group family, just as the Group Leader needs to acknowledge the Rover Crew as self governing. Successful Groups and Crews work hand in hand, ensuring that the Rovers develop and provide effective support to Groups.

It is useful to compare the Scout Group to a family... The Group Leader is the parent and the Rover Crew is the grown up child. It is reasonable for the parent to set some rules of behaviour and obligations to the family, whilst showing respect for the child's need for independence. The Group Leader certainly has the right to say what happens around the Crew den and should be able to expect a Crew to advise him/her about what they are doing and to make an effort to fit into the Group family. Rover Crews should attend the Group Council to let the Group know what they are up to, this allows the Group Leader to report further to the District. If your Crew is not turning up to Group Council, then perhaps it is time to ask why.

The Group Leader is a great resource to assist the Rover Crew in programming and recruitment. The group provides the Crew with some of its program, a Rover Crew should visit the Joey Mob, Cub Scout Pack and Scout Troop at least twice a year and the Venturer Unit at least once a month. The Rover Crew doesn't have to organise the night, remembering that they don't have the training the section leaders do, but they should be able to attend so that the younger sections can see that Rovers do exist. The Crew should be able to attend Group Councils and use their experience and knowledge to help them in difficult times.

A lot of groups see the Rover Crew as the answer to their leadership shortage problems. A Rover Crew is a

good source for recruiting leaders, but it should always be the individual Rover's choice. A Rover crew's obligation to the Group doesn't include providing leaders for the younger sections, but good groups are able to recruit Rovers to leadership roles. Once again it is a balancing act between letting the Rover enjoy their Rovering and to fulfill their obligations to the leadership role they have taken. If the ground rules have been set at the beginning then there are usually no issues later on.

There are many Rover Crews that are active members of their Groups. If Groups can recognise that Rovers are seeking to make their own way in the world and need a degree of independence and can relate to them as a friend and a counselor - never as a director - then the relationship can be truly rewarding for both the Group and the Rovers alike. If a Crew or Group are unsure how to start this process, the Assistant Region Commissioners, Rovers or Branch Commissioners and Rovers would be more than happy to assist in anyway they can...

## Get on the Tram - Saturday 24 February 2007

### PARADE GATHERING AND MARSHALLING

- Scouting members will assemble in front of the Westin in the City Square at 10am.
- Program Commissioners are asked to assemble their section for the march.
- A Chief Parade Marshal will be appointed shortly who will organize the marshaling of sections.
- The parade will be led by the Scouts who were trained at the PR Training Course.
- The next group will be the Joey Scouts with their leaders.
- A large banner will head each section. It will include the name of the section, the age range and the phone number to call to join.
- Section Commissioners should arrange two people (leaders or youth where they can carry the banner) to carry the banner for the duration of the parade.
- The sections will parade through the city in age range order. (Joeys-Cubs-Scouts-Venturers-Rovers)
- Scouts will need to provide marshals at all major intersections

### PUBLIC TRANSPORT & TRAFFIC CONTROL

- Yarra Trams will block and hold all trams on Swanston street from 10.15am until 12noon.
- Yarra Trams will divert all Burke Street Trams from 10.15am – 12 noon
- Scouts Australia will be required to advertise this in the Herald Sun and The Age as part of our advertising for the Scout Expo in Treasury Gardens.
- Yarra Trams will waive any fees associated with the hold up of public transport under the Act.
- Victoria Police will stop all traffic at intersections as the parade approaches and will open intersections as the parade passes
- Scouts Australia will be required to liaise with bus companies and notify them of the intended disruption to services.

### STEPS OF PARLIAMENT

- Scouting members in uniform will gather on the steps of parliament in sections (Joeys at the front and Rovers / Leaders at the back).
- The official ceremony will proceed at this point.
- We may not spill onto the road or disrupt traffic along Spring Street
- Once the official ceremony is finished, members will walk on the footpath to the Treasury gardens using traffic lights and pedestrian crossings.
- Scout marshals will be required at each set of traffic lights.
- The final program for the official proceedings has not yet been finalized but will be distributed when it has

# AJ2007 - Mission Impossible?

“Your mission, Mr Phelps, should you decide to accept it, is ....”

I've always loved the start of the TV series Mission Impossible. It always started with the line above, and proceeded on to some improbable task. Mr Phelps and his impossible missions team always seemed to achieve it in the end.

Like Mr Phelps, our mission was to tell 11 – 14 year old Scouts at the recent Jamboree in Elmore about the wonders and potential delights of being Venturers (the 15-18 Year Old Scouts).

What, you've not heard about the Jamboree? 2007 is the Centenary of the start of Scouting, and Australia has the honour of hosting the first Jamboree for this Centenary year. (For more info see [www.scouts.com.au](http://www.scouts.com.au))

So, how do you organise a Jamboree? Take a 1.5 km square site about 150 km north Melbourne with it's own airport, and prepare to have 10,000 Scouts live on it for 10 days. You can estimate another 2000 or more visitors on the middle weekend. Set up a 200 bed hospital, a Fire Brigade, Police station, add a reverse osmosis water plant to take bore water and make it drinkable, make sure all of the necessary amenities are present, food, shops of all kinds, a carnival and other such delights.

We then took a 40 m by 10 m tent, and put into it both static and visual displays that demonstrated and talked about fun activities like hiking, ski touring, paracending, and, of course scuba diving (amongst many others).

Long-term readers of Dive Log may remember an article published last year about taking 28 Venturer Scouts to Port Stephens for a PADI Open Water dive course. Amongst other exciting happenings, that particular dive course had a pod of dolphins swim through the middle of its students.

Video footage from the dive course was one of the many tools we used to attract potential Venturers at the Jamboree.

However, we wanted to put a fully-equipped scuba diver in a mock pool, preferably with some marine denizen, to illustrate some of the potentialities. I must admit there was a mock igloo with ski touring equipment; a fully equipped campsite, abseiling gear and a caving site as well, as these are all possible Venturer activities.

So how to get a fully equipped diver to go in the pool? I was going to donate my own gear, but I didn't have a mannequin, and I wasn't sure how my tank would take the 40 plus degree temperatures in the tent.

So I turned to my local dive shop (Melbourne Dive Services) to borrow a “failed” hydro test tank, or possibly their plastic demo model. They asked the logical question, which was “What do you want it for?”

I explained I was going to have 12,000 potential divers walk past a scene with a scuba diver in full gear on display. Immediately they saw the possibilities and put me on to Aquanaut, who wholesale well-known brands such as Aqualung, Luxifer, Suunto and USDivers.

Was Darren their Rep interested in helping us? For 12,000 potential divers, he was incredibly happy to give us a hand to promote diving. As I write this, about 1000 people a day are filing past a very well (and expensively) equipped diver standing in a pool observing a white shark. On his outstretched fingers is the sign “More info? [learntoscuba.com.au](http://learntoscuba.com.au)” a message that has been reiterated for every group that goes through.

Let's get back to that shark - he must be a Great White Shark, when I last saw him he had a golf club clasped under his right pectoral fin.
