LONG SERVICE AND GOOD SERVICE AWARD RECOGNITION

The placement of Long Service and Good Service Award emblems is being changed with the introduction of the new, smaller blue background emblems.


In future, the new awards will be worn on the front of the shirt centred directly above the pocket as in the attached diagram. They will now be more easily seen and recognized in conjunction with any civilian and military awards already placed there.

This change will contribute to our priority to Enhance Adult lives through Scouting.

It will give more visible prominence to the record of community service that our Adult leaders and Supporters give to Victorian youth when they mix with other uniformed community service organizations such as the Guides, SES, CFA, Ambulance, St Johns and the Police at community functions such as Australia Day.

Thus from the top left (facing a person) are the Australian flag and World badge; a possible second row of military emblems if any; third row directly above the pocket from the left, Civilian awards and then Scout Good Service and Long service Awards.

Leaders should continue to wear the old khaki background awards on the sleeve until such time as they receive a new one.
